Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 7, 2014, the 800 MHz Transition Administrator notified the FCC that rebanding had been completed in NPSPAC Regions 12 (ID), 16 (KS), 24 (MO) and 25 (MT). Notwithstanding that notification, it is the LMCC's understanding that the FCC will not issue a Public Notice announcing the availability of 800 MHz Expansion Band or Guard Band spectrum in these regions at this time. As the FCC is aware, the frequency advisory committees (FACs) authorized to coordinate this spectrum have not adopted a Memorandum of Agreement establishing procedures to avoid instances of application mutual exclusivity for those frequencies pending the outcome of the LMCC's Petition for Rulemaking filed on March 27, 2014, for which industry comments were submitted in response to the FCC's Public Notice in RM-11719. Once the FCC acts on that Petition, the FACs will work promptly to implement appropriate coordination procedures for these frequencies.
